TALKING POINTS and relevant notes:

- **Introduction to the Literacy programs in Konik camp**
- ✓ Mr Lekovic introduced the ongoing activities to teachers all of whom have significant experience in working with Roma students from the camp and from the area;
- ✓ Teachers' experience in Literacy/Numeracy programs spans from 1 to 20 years approximately
- **Literacy Cubed - Focus on Roma Families (project description)**
- Mr Lekovic talked about the rationale and organization – about 6-7 teachers knew about the program through their communication with the community and PCMNE
- **FLP Piloting Experiences during Summer 2014**
- ✓ Mrs Blecic and Mr Lekovic explained in detail organization of the workshops, and the role of trainers.
- ✓ Teachers were interested to hear more about the training for the trainers (which took place in Cluj)
- **Ongoing Activities in the project**
- ✓ Ms Blecic mentioned goals of the Policy Brief and Local strategies, and involvement of the MoE and BoE professionals who work with teachers on a regular basis.
- **The role of teachers in FLP in Podgorica, Montenegro...**
- ✓ Teachers mention an overload they are facing (teaching+administration) but that they may participate in promoting the program in the future through parents' meetings, professional development meetings with colleagues from other municipalities etc.
- ✓ Where to get FLP information (the role of PCMNE office)
